Q1: Do I need to edit my parameters in ClearPath?



- Year: baseline year (2019).
- **Population**: population of the entire municipality in baseline year.
- **Status**: Keep status as 'In Progress' until inventory is approved by ICLEI, then move to 'complete'.
- Check box: 'Official Inventory for Selected Year'.
- Additional information can be left blank.

Q2. Do I need to add anything to the 'Notes' section of the Record in ClearPath?



- Add any data assumptions/gaps.
- Include who entered the record with the date of entry so you can track any changes that are made.
- Attach/upload the data source and data request response for each record.

This information will make it easier for others to review your inventory and understand the methods used for future inventories.



What are factor sets again?

- For a number of greenhouse gas calculations there are variables that may change depending on your location (and sometimes the year) for which your inventory is being performed.
- These same variables may be needed for a variety of calculations throughout your inventory.
- In order to reduce repetitive data entry, factor sets were created for some of the most common types of variables that are used this way, including for grid electricity emissions.





Q5: On page 17-18 of the GHG Inventory Report Template, there is a table that asks for MPGs and the emission factors by vehicle type. Where do I find that data?

• This data should show up automatically when you download the summary report from ClearPath.




Q6: I am trying to run the report 'Inventory Comparison by Scope' but I'm getting an error message?

- Go to Edit Parameters.
- Click box: 'Official Inventory for Selected Year'.
- Click Save.

Q7: Is it OK if I'm not finished my inventory report by the July meeting?
